The Student Ambassador Position:

We are looking for passionate education students—either Bachelor or Masters—from across Canada to help contribute to making education more equitable. As a Student Ambassador, you will join our team of young Canadian leaders and spearhead Teach For Canada initiatives on your campus, including:

- Amplifying First Nations' calls for committed educators in the North
- Leading Teach For Canada campus awareness initiatives on educational inequities and the strength of northern First Nation communities
- Designing communication and recruitment strategies to inspire community-focused B.Ed. candidates to apply to join Teach For Canada's 2018 cohort of teachers
- Identifying and connecting with strong prospective applicants who want to make a difference
- Serving as your university's on-campus resource and advisor to Teach For Canada

All Student Ambassadors will convene in Toronto in mid-October for the Student Ambassador Forum where they will hear from First Nations' community partners, discuss awareness-raising strategies, and collaborate on Teach For Canada's broader goals.
